

## Parish Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes for April 28, 2009

- I. The meeting opened with prayer.
- II. The Minutes from the last meeting (March 24<sup>th</sup>) were reviewed and approved.
- III. Fr. Tom gave the Pastor's Report.
  - a. Fr. Quinn's last official day at the parish is Thursday (April 30<sup>th</sup>), so he asked to be excused from tonight's meeting. He will be returning to on Sunday, May 10<sup>th</sup>, and Fr. Tom would like to surprise him by taking a second collection for St. Joseph's Retreat Center (the summer headquarters for Catholic Youth Expeditions).
  - b. Fr. Tom and Fr. Quinn met with Bishop Ricken and discussed the rectory at St. Pius X becoming a "house of formation" for men discerning a vocation to the priesthood. The rectory can be divided into six bedrooms (i.e., four bedrooms in addition to Fr. Tom's and Fr. Quinn's). The Diocese will be paying the parish a monthly allowance for Fr. Quinn's room and board.
  - c. The parish is hoping to be assigned a new associate pastor in June.
  - d. Fr. Tom stated that he is going to miss Fr. Quinn.
  - e. Fr. Norm is coming to help with Confessions in May.
  - f. Fr. Tom is very happy to be here at St. Pius X.
  - g. The Warming Shelter was at St. Pius X the week beginning Easter Sunday, and all went well. (St. Pius X School was closed for Easter Break.) The shelter served 17 or 18 people.
- IV. Liaison Reports:
  - a. Brian Schwartz (Stewardship Committee) was the only liaison with anything to report.
    1. The Stewardship Committee is very active.
    2. The Stewardship Committee is researching getting nametags for all parishioners.
    3. John Petit wants to approach all parishioners about stewardship by first inviting everyone to church. The details need to be worked out, and John will present the idea to the Parish Pastoral Council.
    4. Future Plans:
      - A. Promote Bible study and Sacrament programs.

B. Contact families a year after Baptism to check on folks.
